Dear Chairwoman Collins, Vice Chair Murray, and Honorable Members of the Committee,

Conservation Technical Assistance (CTA) at the U.S. Department of Agriculture Natural Resources Conservation Service (USDA-NRCS) provides necessary and invaluable aid to farmers and ranchers to adopt conservation practices. These funds support local conservation districts and USDA offices which 68-73% of farmers and ranchers identified as their most trusted source of information in a recent nationwide poll. Investments in CTA benefit all Americans by bolstering soil health, improving water quality, and protecting wildlife habitat – we encourage you and your colleagues to fully fund CTA in the FY26 appropriations package.

Implementing conservation practices often requires changes to how a farm or ranch manages its natural resources. CTA ensures NRCS staff are available to provide critical advice and technical expertise in the process. Local staff also help producers navigate program applications and legal requirements so they can access USDA programs and receive financial assistance. This personalized and complimentary service structure supports producers in overcoming barriers to more effective land stewardship.

Local staff, funded by CTA, serve as the bridge between producers and USDA conservation programs. In 2024, USDA invested \$3.8 billion to two flagship NRCS programs, the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) and the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP), including \$747 million on over 5.8 million acres in the Midwest. These voluntary, incentive-based programs are persistently oversubscribed, with EQIP and CSP accepting only 43% and 53% of applications, respectively, in 2024.

Adequate funding for CTA enables farmers and ranchers to adopt practices that improve soil health, water quality, and wildlife habitat, while meeting their operations' unique needs and improving bottom lines. Continued support for America's producers, and the nation's lands, is necessary for a healthy agricultural economy and ensuring food security for future generations.

The undersigned organizations recognize producer demand and desire for conservation technical assistance and its critical role in getting conservation practices on the ground. As such, we write in strong support of maintaining or increasing appropriated FY2026 CTA funding levels from the \$776.5 million appropriated in FY2025. We urge you to invest in this vital support for farmers and ranchers across the country.
