## MENU OF OFFERINGS

### CLASSROOM LESSONS (VIRTUAL & IN PERSON)

Virtual lessons are offered to all K-12 classrooms in the greater Metro Area. When it is safe, our in-person lessons are offered to schools in Minneapolis and Saint Paul. Topics include invasive species, wetlands, watersheds, and erosion.

### STORM DRAIN STENCILING & CLEAN UPS

K-12 groups located in Minneapolis or Saint Paul can schedule a stenciling or clean up outing near their location. All other groups need to provide their own transportation to a location in Minneapolis or Saint Paul.

### STEWARDSHIP & RESTORATION PARTNERSHIPS

FMR works at natural sites across the greater metro area. Interested partners work with FMR staff to determine if your K-12 group is located near an FMR site to create an ongoing learning experience for your school or classroom.

### SERVICE LEARNING PROJECTS & VOLUNTEERING

FMR can support independent youth service projects on a case by case basis. This opportunity is open to youth in elementary school through college. Many of our public events can also be applied as volunteer hours for classes and programs.

### ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP INSTITUTE

The FMR Environmental Stewardship Institute offers paid opportunities for high schoolers and rising college freshmen to gain experience in the environmental field.
